

Junior Volunteer Immunizations Requirements

As a Junior Volunteer, you will not continue through the volunteer applicant process or start volunteering without being cleared.

All volunteers at The Christ Hospital Health Network are **required** to have the following:

- Blood test for Tuberculosis status or 2 Step Tuberculin Skin Test
- Immunization records for Measles, Mumps, Rubella and Varicella
- Immunization records for T-Dap (whooping cough) vaccination
- Immunization records for Flu vaccination (During flu season only, October to April)

If you are under the age of 18, you will need to make an appointment with your Physician or outpatient clinic (I.E., Kroger, Little Clinic) to receive any vaccinations you currently do not have. If you are 18 and older, the Tuberculosis test is provided <u>FREE</u> of charge at the hospital. More information will be provided during your interview.
