- Graduate of an ACPE-accredited College of Pharmacy with a Doctor of Pharmacy degree
- Eligible for pharmacist licensure in Ohio
- US citizen or legal resident
- Meets criteria for employment at The Christ Hospital including criminal background check, and negative drug and tobacco screens

Documentation: PhORCAS is utilized for all application submissions

- Curriculum vitae
- Letter of Interest
- Four references
- Supplementary application material described on website

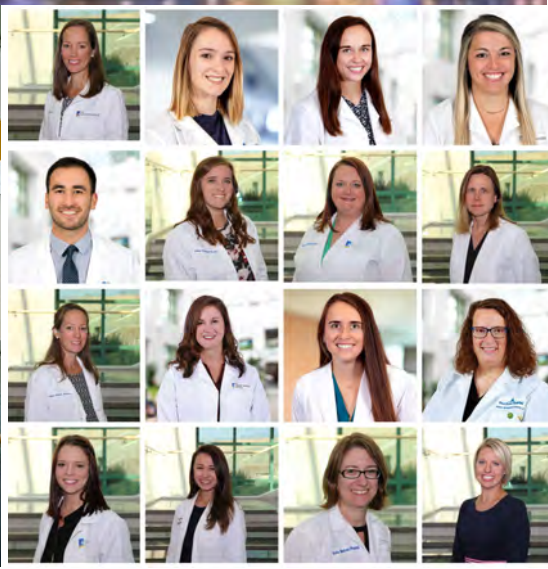
